

“GENERAL RULES FOR HIGH HAND OF THE HOUR PROMOTION”

1. The “High Hand of the Hour– Promotion” (hereinafter the “Promotion”) refers to the events occurring daily in the Poker Room of “Golden Nugget Las Vegas” in Las Vegas, Nevada, on all eligible Poker games beginning on August 01, 2022.
2. Golden Nugget Las Vegas reserves the right to refuse anyone entry into the Promotion, in its sole and absolute discretion.
3. Promotion is limited to participants 21 years of age or older with proof of age that Golden Nugget Las Vegas, acting in its sole and absolute discretion, deems appropriate.
4. Void where prohibited or restricted by law.
5. The Promotion is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations, including gaming, and all aspects of the Promotion are subject to the approval of appropriate regulatory authorities.
6. Winners must show their valid picture identification (driver’s license, state identification card, or military identification card) in order to collect prize. If winner is not a U.S. citizen, a current passport or passport card is required. A Canadian driver’s license is also acceptable.
7. Winners agree to grant Golden Nugget Las Vegas unconditional use of their name and likeness for promotions / advertising and announcements without compensation, consideration, notice review, or further consent.
8. Winners are responsible for any and all taxes, licenses, registrations and other fees.
9. All tax laws foreign and domestic apply. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
10. Winnings may be subject to reporting and withholding pursuant to Federal IRS regulations, and participants are required to cooperate with Golden Nugget Las Vegas in completing necessary forms, such as a W-9, W-2G or 1042-S.
11. All decisions regarding the interpretation of the rules, eligibility, scheduling and staging of the Promotion, and penalties for misconduct lie solely with Golden Nugget Las Vegas, whose decisions are final.
12. Golden Nugget Las Vegas may cancel, modify, or reschedule any portion of the Promotion at anytime without prior notice, except for notification that may be required to be given to the appropriate gaming regulators pursuant to applicable law or regulation.
13. Golden Nugget Las Vegas may disqualify any person for any prize based upon fraud, dishonesty, violation of the official rules or other misconduct while on the property or otherwise occurring whether or not relating to the Promotion or as otherwise reasonable or necessary for Golden Nugget Las Vegas to comply with applicable statutes and regulations, in its sole and absolute discretion.
14. Golden Nugget Las Vegas is not responsible for injuries or losses arising or resulting from participation in the Promotion and is not liable for any acts or omissions by employees, whether negligent or willful, in the conduct of the Promotion, and is not liable in the event of any equipment or software malfunction.
15. Golden Nugget Las Vegas is not responsible for electronic transmission errors or delays resulting in omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operations or transmission, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to or alterations of entry materials, or for

technical, hardware, software, or telephone failures of any kind, lost or unavailable connections, fraud, incomplete, garbled, or delayed computer transmissions, whether caused by Golden Nugget Las Vegas, users, or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Promotion or by any technical or human error which may occur in the processing of submissions which may limit, restrict, or prevent a participant's ability to participate in the Promotion.

16. If for any reason the Promotion is not capable of running as planned, including infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other causes within or beyond the control of Golden Nugget Las Vegas which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of the Promotion, Golden Nugget Las Vegas reserves the right at its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Promotion
17. Any attempt by any person to deliberately damage any program or to undermine the legitimate operation of the Promotion may be a violation of criminal and civil laws and should such an attempt be made, Golden Nugget Las Vegas reserves the right to seek damages from any such person to the fullest extent of the law.
18. Prizes are non-transferable.
19. Individuals who are excluded from Golden Nugget Las Vegas facilities, either through a government program or by their own request, are not eligible.
20. Employees of Golden nugget Las Vegas that require a gaming license are not eligible to participate.
21. By participation in the Promotion, participants agree to comply with all rules contained herein.

PROMOTION SPECIFIC RULES:

1. Players participating in Texas Hold'em Poker games, excluding tournaments, in which player revenue from the pot is retained for house fees (the "House Rake") shall be required to fund an additional rake for use in various promotions, drawings, and jackpots (the "Jackpot Rake").
2. A jackpot rake of \$1 will be taken when the pot reaches \$10. The full jackpot rake of \$2 will be taken when the pot reaches \$20.
3. Monies will be awarded to the Texas Hold'em High Hand of the Hour each day from 12midnight through 8am.
4. The hourly qualifying period is from the top of each hour, through :59 minutes after each hour.
5. Time will be established for a high hand when the dealer calls the hand out. If the call is made from the top of the hour through 59 minutes after, it will qualify for the current hour. If not, it will qualify for the next hour.
6. \$200 will be awarded for the High Hand of the Hour.
7. This promotion applies to "live" Texas Hold'em cash games only. Games may be excluded by player request.

8. Any Aces full or better qualifies. If the minimum qualifying hand is not met during the hour, the monies will be carried over to the next hour. The monies will carry over until a winning qualifying hand is made. Money may carry over to the following day if there is no winning hand between 7:00am and 7:59am.
9. There will be one extra \$200 high hand of the hour payout on Sunday, November 7, 2021 for the Daylight Savings Time adjustment from 2:00am back to 1:00am. There will be one less \$200 high hand of the hour payout Sunday, March 14, 2021 for the Daylight Savings Time adjustment from 2:00am forward to 3:00am.
10. High Hand Jackpot requirements:
 - a. Texas Hold'em- Both hole cards must play to make the best Five-Card hand.
11. In the event of a tie, kickers will count for four of a kinds, and suits will determine the winner for straight and royal flushes (spade, heart, diamond, club from highest to lowest). If a tie occurs in any other situation, the prize will be divided equally.
12. A player making a potential qualifying hand must notify the dealer and/or a supervisor immediately upon completion of the hand. Failure to do so may disqualify the hand's eligibility.
13. All qualifying hands will be documented and maintained at the poker podium in order of succession.
14. The winning high hand will be announced at the end of each hour's qualifying period.
15. The High Hand Jackpot monies will be kept separate from the House rake and will be picked up by the Casino Drop Team to be counted and recorded once a day.
16. Players must take possession of their hand to become eligible for any portion of the High Hand Jackpots.
17. Any discussion of the High Hand Jackpot during a hand may void any payments.
18. There must be at least \$10.00 in the pot for a hand to qualify for a High Hand of the Hour Jackpot.
19. House and Jackpot Rakes received for the hand in question shall count toward the pot size in determining whether the pot contains the minimum amount required for a qualifying hand.
20. Reduced rake games qualify for the High Hand Jackpots only if the full jackpot rake is being taken on each hand.
21. There must be at least 4 (four) participants dealt into a hand for a hand to qualify for a High Hand of the Hour Jackpot. Tables with less than 4 (four) participants are not eligible. Players with a missed blind button are not counted towards the 4 (four) players necessary for a hand to be eligible.
22. All qualifying hands must be verified by the Golden Nugget Poker Room Shift Manager prior to making the payout. The dealer must count down the deck. A defective deck will void all winnings. The jackpot winner must sign for all winnings.
23. The Shift Manager will record the winning hand and the time when the hand was hit.

24. The winning player must produce a valid form of identification and sign for all winnings. The current dealer must sign as a witness to the payout. The Poker Room Supervisor must sign upon paying out the customer.
25. If the winning player fails to produce a valid form of identification the jackpot will not be paid. The jackpot monies will be held for up to, but no more than sixty (60) days. At that time if the jackpot has still not been claimed with a valid form of identification the monies will be distributed back into the poker room promotional pool.
26. Winners shall receive payment of the High Hand of the Hour in Golden Nugget chips and shall not be entitled to receive any other form of payment.
27. Any applicable taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner. All required tax forms will be signed before paying the winners.
28. Any dispute that is not covered by these rules will be resolved in a manner deemed by the Golden Nugget Poker Room Management to be fairest to all involved, subject to NRS 463.362
29. The Jackpot Rake shall be allocated towards Poker promotions as follows:

| Percentage of Jackpot Rake | Name of Promotion |
|-----------------------------------|---------------------------------------------|
| 95% | High Hand Jackpots & Reserve for Promotions |
| 5% | Progressive Bad Beat Jackpot Promotion |

30. The Reserve is a holding fund for the Jackpot Rake that is not paid out for the hand for which it is raked and is utilized for the purpose of funding and resetting the Jackpots after being hit as well as other promotional activities.
